Biography

JOHANNES W. VIEWEG, M.D., F.A.C.S., received his medical degree from the Technical University of Munich, Germany, and began his residency training at the University of Ulm. After relocating to the United States, he completed three years of postdoctoral training at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center before completing his urology residency training at Duke University Medical Center. He had a nine-year tenure on the Duke urology faculty.

In 2006, Vieweg joined the University of Florida and oversees a large network of urologists in northern and central Florida. He is the Chair of the State of Florida Prostate Cancer Advisory Council and holds the Huizenga Eminent Scholar Endowed Chair in urologic oncology at UF. He is an internationally recognized authority in urologic oncology and has a focused interest in cancer immunology and gene-based therapies.

Vieweg is an attending surgeon at the Malcom Randall Veterans Affairs Medical Center. He also chairs the research council of the American Urological Association and the State of Florida Prostate Cancer Advisory Council, and is a 2012 inductee into the American Association of Genitourinary Surgeons, an association of leading academic urologists from various nations.
